










Figure 10 Distribution of the population aged 15-65 by labour market status and population group Census 1996 and 2001













Figure 17 Distribution of households by type of dwelling and population group of the household head Census 1996 and 2001




Figure 18 Percentage of households using electricity for lighting by population group of the household head Census 1996 and 2001




Figure 19 Distribution of households by main source of water and population group of head of household Census 1996 and 2001






Figure 20 Distribution of households by type of toilet facility and population group of the household head Census 1996 and 2001
